Kancheepuram is a newly formed Lok Sabha (Parliament of India) constituency after the 2008 delimitation.^[2] Its Tamil Nadu Parliamentary Constituency number is 6 of 39.

The constituency originally existed for the 1951 election.

This constituency is reserved for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates.
