

# Mayiladuthurai Lok Sabha constituency

Coordinates: 11°06′07"N 79°34′47"E

**Mayiladuthurai** is a <u>Lok Sabha</u> (Parliament of India) constituency in <u>Tamil Nadu</u>. Its <u>Tamil Nadu</u> Parliamentary Constituency number is 28 of 39. It spreads on two districts, Mayiladuthurai and Thanjavur.

# History

Mayiladuthurai (Lok Sabha constituency) has six assembly constituencies — <u>Mayiladuthurai</u>, <u>Sirkali</u> (SC), <u>Poompuhar</u>, Thiruvidaimarudur (SC), Kumbakonam and Papanasam.

The constituency was constituted during the third <u>Lok Sabha</u> (lower house) as Mayuram until the 1980 elections, when it was renamed Mayiladuthurai. <sup>[2][3]</sup> During the first elections in 1957, Mayiladuthurai was part of Chidambaram constituency and was held by the <u>Indian National Congress</u> party. <sup>[4]</sup> From 1962, the Mayiladuthurai parliament seat was held by the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) twice between 1967 and 1971, <sup>[5][6]</sup> and from 1971 to 1977, <sup>[7]</sup> <u>Tamil Maanila Congress</u> for two terms between 1998 and 1999, <sup>[8]</sup> <sup>[9]</sup> and 1996 to 1998, <sup>[10]</sup> <u>Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam</u> twice during 2009 and 2014, Indian National Congress for eight terms during 1962–67, <sup>[2]</sup> 1977–80, <sup>[7]</sup> 1980–84, <sup>[3]</sup> 1984–89, <sup>[11]</sup> 1989–91, <sup>[12]</sup> 1991–96, <sup>[13]</sup> 1999–2004, <sup>[9]</sup> and 2004–09. <sup>[14]</sup>

Popular Communist leader <u>K. Ananda Nambiar</u> represented Mayiladuthurai in the <u>Lok Sabha</u> from 1951 to 1957. [15] <u>Mani Shankar Aiyar</u> who served as a minister in India's cabinet was elected to the Parliament from the Mayiladuthurai Lok Sabha constituency in the 1991, [16] 1999[17] and 2004 elections. [18] in 2014, the Member of Parliament from the constituency was R.K. Bharathi Mohan of the AIADMK party. [19]

The current Member of Parliament from the constituency is  $\underline{S}$ . Ramalingam of the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam party.


